#### **CLIL Skills and Classroom English**

#### Target group

Both language and subject teachers who wish to integrate CLIL skills into their lessons and subject teachers who need to work on their Classroom English.

#### **Course objectives**

#### Language and subject teachers:

- Develop knowledge about specific CLIL methodology in the classroom
- Develop the necessary skills to successfully teach in the CLIL classroom and to design effective CLIL activities

#### **Subject teachers:**

- Extend language proficiency
- Prepare for Cambridge Advanced Exam

#### **Programme**

The course consists of 13 seminars of three hours in which CLIL methodology is combined with language training. The programme has been developed together with the Academic Language Centre of Leiden University.

#### Language requirements and intake interview

A command of English at B2 level of the Common European Framework is required for this course. Prior to this course, subject teachers will be invited for an intake (written and oral test) to assess whether participants meet the language requirements.

#### Course dates and application

#### **Costs**

In-house delivery: € 15.000 (maximum group size: 16), including course materials and the handbook *CLIL Skills*. Not included: intake (€ 100 per participant), language course books and Cambridge Advanced Exam fee.

#### **Putting CLIL into Practice**

#### Target group

Both language and subject teachers who have little or no experience in CLIL methodology and wish to develop their CLIL skills in the classroom.

#### **Course objectives**

- · Acquire basic knowledge of the most widely recognized methodological CLIL principles
- · Gain ideas how to design and evaluate CLIL teaching materials

#### **Programme**

This hands-on course consists of five afternoon seminars in which participants explore practical CLIL activities, watch DVDs of actual CLIL classroom practice and discuss the pedagogy of CLIL teaching. To meet participants' specific needs and wants, individual seminars can also be attended.

#### Professional development of a CLIL team

#### Target group

This tailor-made training will suit more experienced CLIL teams who wish to further develop their CLIL knowledge and skills.

#### **Tailor-made CLIL training**

Training content and length depends on specific needs and questions, and the training is therefore designed in cooperation with the CLIL team. For example, the following issues can be covered in one or more seminars:

#### CLIL methodology: advanced teaching techniques

 How can subject teachers effectively incorporate language teaching techniques into their CLIL lessons?

#### **CLIL** material design

• How can CLIL teachers design effective, motivating and challenging CLIL material?

#### Cross curricular collaboration

 How can subject and language teachers work more closely together in- and outside the CLIL classroom?

#### Assessment in the CLIL classroom

How can CLIL teachers provide appropriate feedback in a more efficient way?

#### **CLIL** video coaching

As a follow up on any of the above mentioned seminars, or in its own right, ICLON can also offer video coaching for CLIL teachers or teams who wish to share experiences of good CLIL practice and to further develop their CLIL expertise. This coaching consists of three steps:

- · Plenary session to introduce and discuss our approach to coaching, illlustrated by video fragments of CLIL teachers in action
- · CLIL teachers are videotaped during their lessons. Each lesson is discussed and evaluated individually afterwards
- During a closing plenary session, parts of videotaped lessons are used to reflect on good CLIL practice and to identify areas for further development

#### Target group

Experienced CLIL teachers who wish to develop specific CLIL coaching skills to effectively peer-coach their colleagues and mentor student trainees.

#### **Course objectives**

- · Develop practical knowledge of useful strategies for coaching and mentoring CLIL trainees and /or colleagues
- Develop skills to observe and provide effective feedback to CLIL trainees and/or colleagues

#### **Programme**

This hands-on course consists of four afternoon seminars in which participants develop their coaching skills using videotaped examples of actual CLIL classroom practice and discuss coaching issues in relation to CLIL methodology. During the course the participants should ideally be involved in the coaching of at least one colleague or trainee teacher, preferably in their own subject or in a related subject.
